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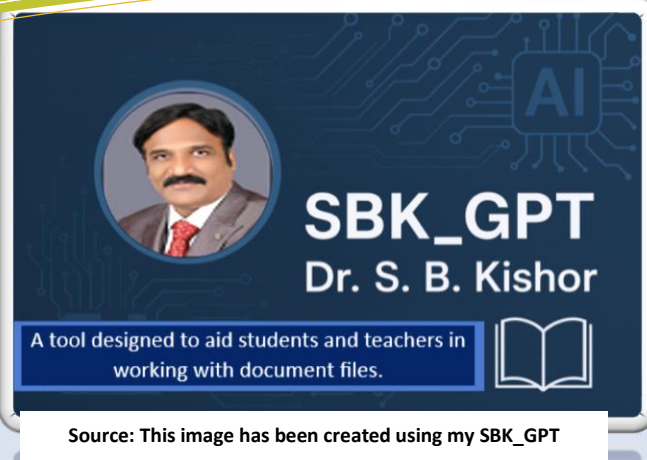

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Customized GPT – Dr. S. B. Kishor

What is a Customized GPT?

A customized GPT is a tailored version of ChatGPT that you configure for a specific purpose. It can have:

- Unique instructions and behavior
- Uploaded knowledge files
- Controlled visibility (private, link-share, or public)

Steps to Create a Customized GPT

1. Start the Builder
 - Go to ChatGPT → Explore GPTs → Create
 - Choose Chat with Builder or Manual setup
2. Define Identity & Behavior
 - Add name, description, profile image
 - Write detailed instructions (tone, goals, do/don't)
3. Upload Knowledge (Optional)
 - Add reference files (PDF, DOCX, etc.)
 - Up to 20 files, 512 MB each
4. Enable Tools (Optional)
 - Toggle browsing, file uploads, image generation
 - Add custom Actions to call external APIs
5. Configure Actions (If Used)
 - Verify domains, set authentication
 - Add privacy policy if publishing
6. Test & Refine
 - Chat with it, try different questions
 - Adjust instructions for better results
7. Set Visibility & Publish
 - Keep private, share link, or make public in GPT Store

Development of AI-Based Teaching Tools

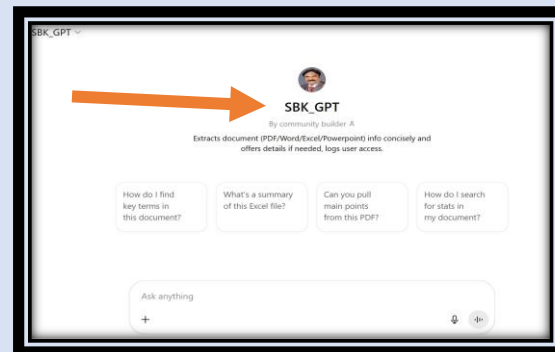

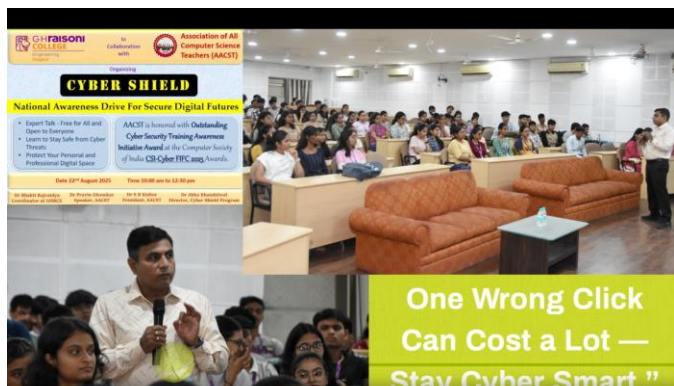

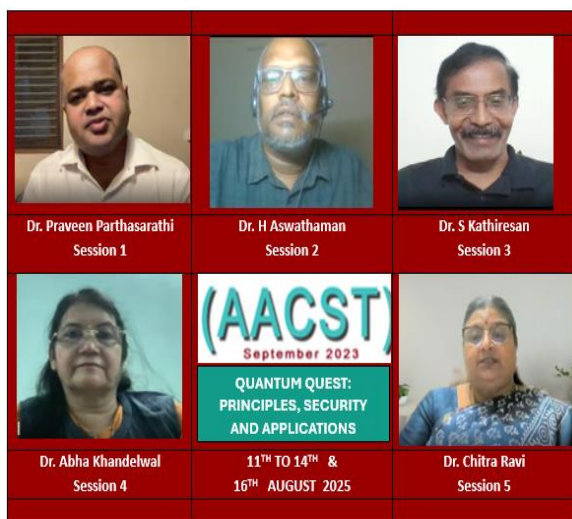
