HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WORKSHOP

Participation: 63 students participated from multiple states across India.

Objective: To equip participants with basic to advanced Python skills for data analysis, visualization, automation, and small projects.

Structure: Sessions progressed from fundamentals to hands-on mini projects, ensuring practical learning and application.

WORKSHOP STRUCTURE

Duration: 8-day progressive Python learning program.

- **Days 1–2:** Python basics, syntax, I/O, and operators.
- **Day 3:** Decision-making and loops.
- **Day 4:** Functions and variable scope.
- **Day 5:** Core data structures.
- **Day 6:** NumPy & Matplotlib for data handling and visualization.
- **Day 7:** Pandas and CSV-based data analysis.
- **Day 8:** Strings and mini projects integrating all concepts.

GOOGLE CLASSROOM INTEGRATION

Learning Support: A dedicated Google Classroom was used as a central learning hub.

- **Resources:** Session-wise study materials and demonstrated Python code files.
- **Practice:** Daily assessments for hands-on reinforcement.
- **Evaluation:** A final test to assess overall understanding.

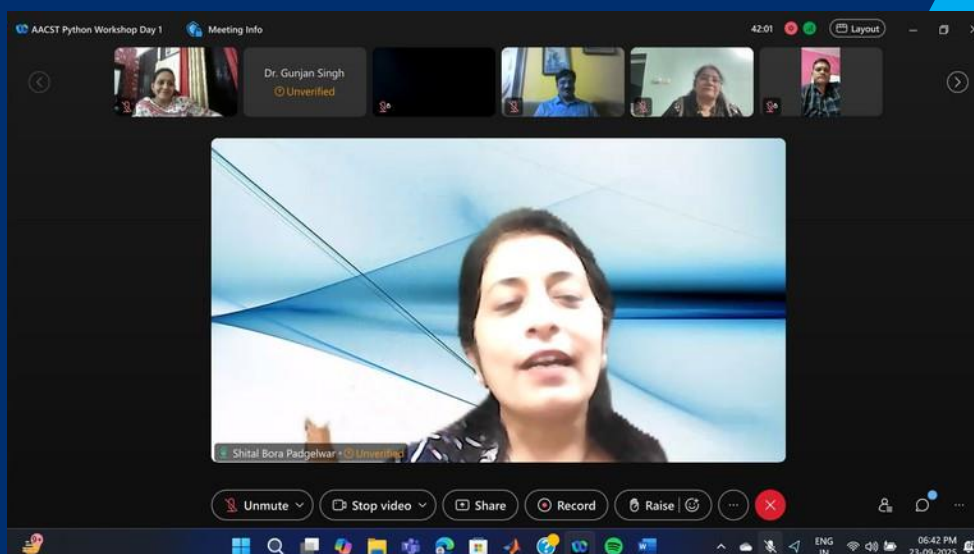

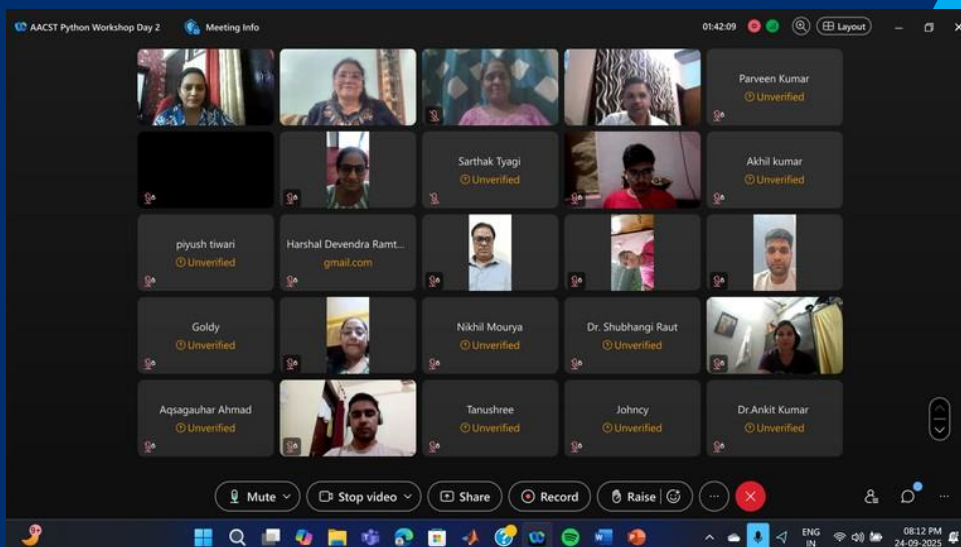
