

National Level Intercollegiate Online Binary Brain Quiz Competition – A Grand Success!

The Binary Brain Online Quiz Competition, a national-level intercollegiate event organized by [Organizing Institution(s)], was successfully conducted from October 20 to October 29, 2024. The competition, held in collaboration with the Association of All Computer Science Teachers (AACST) and Hislop College, Nagpur, focused on basic computer skills, providing a platform for students to demonstrate their foundational knowledge in computer science and digital literacy. The target participants were from all streams, inclusive of Arts, Commerce, and Science.

Objective of the Competition

The primary objective of the competition was to assess and enhance students' fundamental understanding of computer concepts, fostering a culture of digital competence and critical thinking.

Competition Format

The competition was conducted in three progressive levels:

1. Level 1:
 - Format: Online MCQ (Google Form)
 - Participants: Open to all students across India
 - Focus: Basic computer skills and foundational knowledge
 - Outcome: Participation certificates for all
2. Level 2:
 - Format: Online MCQ (Google Form)
 - Participants: Top two scorers from each institution formed a team
 - Focus: Advanced applications of basic computer skills
 - Outcome: Top 5 teams were selected for the final round
3. Level 3:
 - Format: Hybrid (In-person/Google Meet)
 - Participants: Top 5 teams
 - Focus: Team-based problem-solving and practical application of computer skills
 - Outcome: Winners were awarded medals and certificates

Participation Highlights

- Total Universities: 5
- Total Institutions Participated: 19
- Total Participants: 452

The event attracted students from various academic streams, showcasing the widespread importance of basic computer skills in diverse disciplines.
