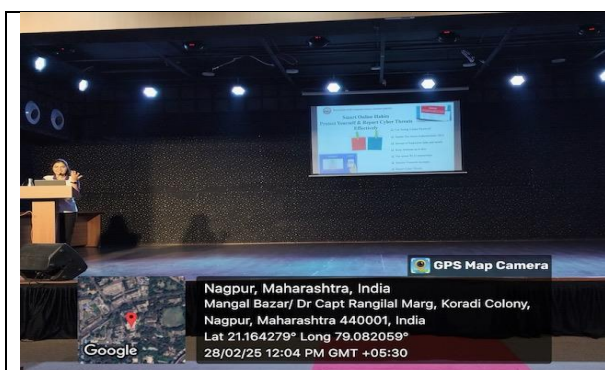

This initiative successfully empowered participants with **essential knowledge and practical tools** to navigate the digital world **safely and responsibly**.

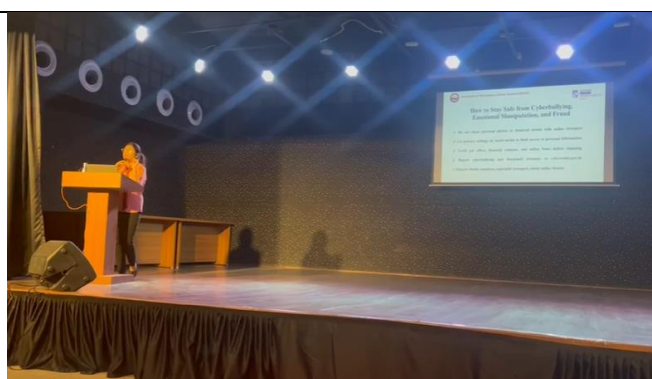
