Event Name: National Level Quiz Sangam Senior 2025

Organized by: Hislop College, Nagpur

In Collaboration with: Association of All Computer Science Teachers (AACST)

Objective:

The primary objective of the *National Level Quiz Sangam Senior 2025* was to encourage and recognize excellence in the diverse field among students at the national level. The event aimed to provide a common platform for aspiring learners to showcase their knowledge, analytical ability, and awareness of emerging trends in technology.

Event Details:

The *National Level Quiz Sangam Senior 2025* witnessed enthusiastic participation from **251 students representing various states of the nation**.

The competition was conducted in **multiple stages** to ensure a fair and comprehensive evaluation of participants' knowledge and reasoning skills.

Eligibility:

Participation was **open to students from all streams** across institutions nationwide.

Event Structure:

The competition was organized in **three stages** to progressively identify and reward excellence at institutional and national levels:

- **Stage 1 (Preliminary Round)** — *5th October 2025*
All 251 registered participants appeared for this round. Based on their performance, **40 institutional toppers** were shortlisted for Stage 2.
To ensure fairness and authenticity, the **Proctored App** was used for integrity verification and participant monitoring during this stage.
- **Stage 2 (Inter-Institutional Round)** — *12th October 2025*
The institutional toppers competed for a place in the Final National Round. **28 participants** qualified for the national finals through this stage.
This round was also conducted under **Proctored App** supervision to maintain evaluation credibility and transparency.
- **Final National Round** — *14th October 2025*
Conducted in a **classroom-like environment via Google Meet**, in the presence of the **Mentor, Convener, and Regional Coordinators**.
The 28 national finalists were divided into four batches of seven each. **22 finalists appeared** for this round.

Quiz Format and Sections:

The quiz comprised **MCQ-type questions** covering the following sections:

- *Current Affairs*
- *Basic Computer Literacy*
- *General Aptitude*
- *English Language & Literature Spark*

There was **no negative marking** in round one and **negative marking** was given for second round.

Judging Criteria:

Each round assessed participants on **conceptual clarity, speed, accuracy, and application-based understanding** of the subject.

Result Declaration:

The **final results were declared on 6th October 2025** for **Institutional Winners** and on **16th October 2025** for **National Winners**.

Institutional Winners:

The **Institutional Toppers** of Stage 1 were awarded **Certificates of Excellence** for their exceptional performance and representation of their respective institutions.

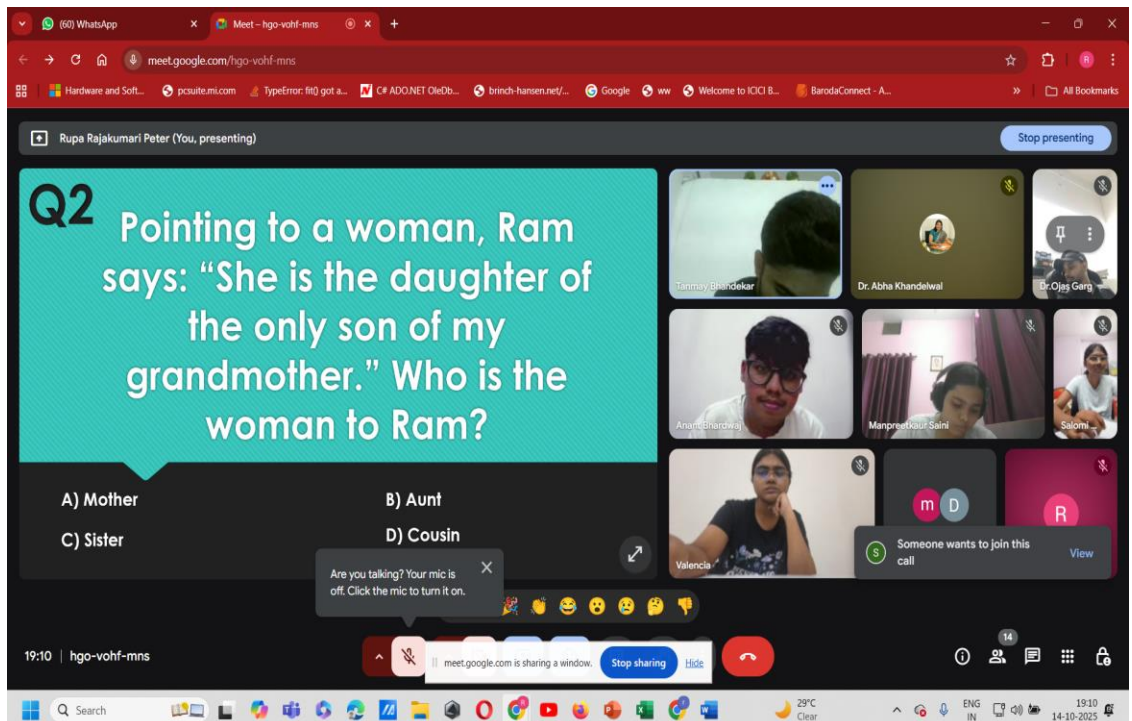

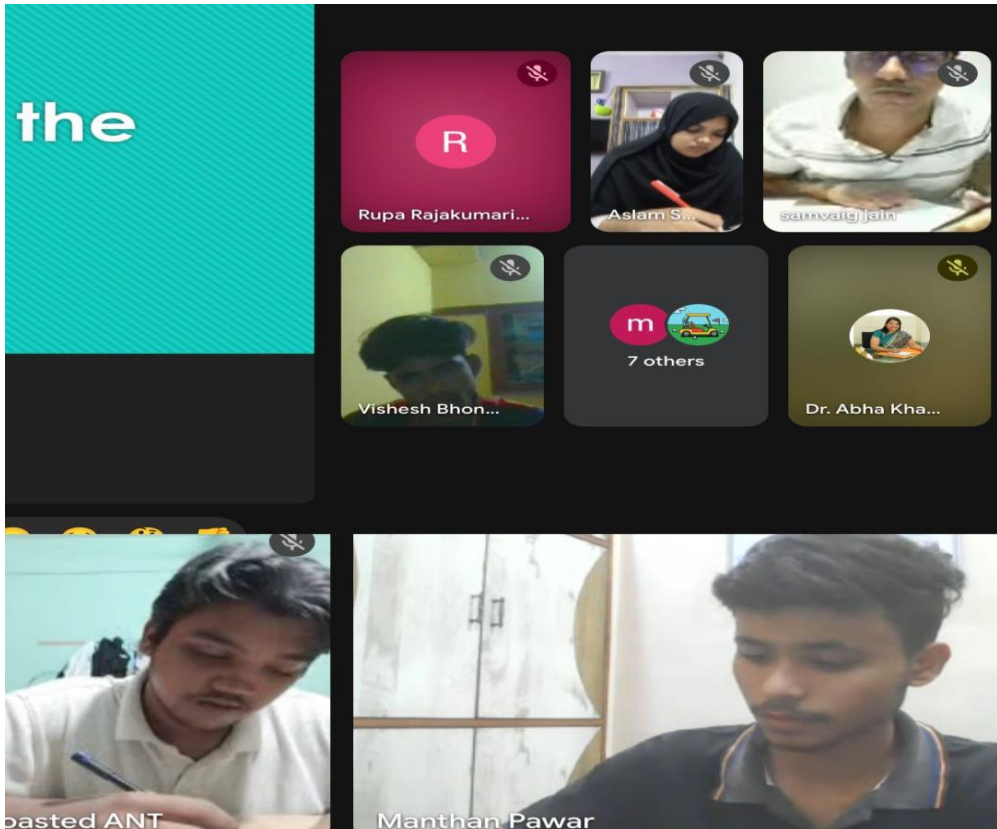
